



Standard Size Program Series 1000

The standard size program was created to offer certain market segments access to Fleetwood quality but at a price point more conducive to non-custom applications. Most of the cost savings can be traced to the 'batch' fabrication of the vertical frame and panel parts. Related, the lead-time for Standard Size doors is typically one week longer than custom sizes as the batch runs are randomly scheduled.
